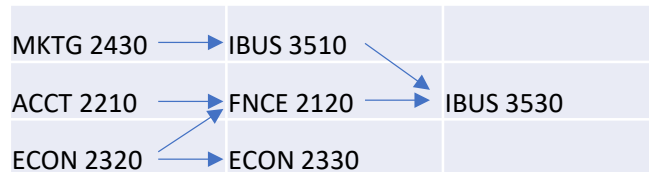


Key Course Sequences
