

GUIDELINES FOR PRE-DENTISTRY (DMD) – UBC

The Faculty of Dentistry at UBC offers a dental education program consisting of four years of professional study leading to the degree of Doctor of Dental Medicine (DMD).

Admission to DMD at UBC requires a minimum of 90 post-secondary credits transferable to UBC (completed by August 31 of the year prior to admission). A minimum, cumulative average of 70% or 2.8 GPA average (including failed courses) is required. Admission to DMD is extremely competitive and most applicants have more than the minimum number of credits and GPA.

The number of students accepted each year varies from year to year with up to 70 seats allocated to the program. A portion of these seats ae allocated to both International and Indigenous applicants.

Students planning to apply for admission to the Doctor of Dental Medicine (DMD) program at UBC should select courses that satisfy the requirements of a Bachelor's degree of their choice, along with the <u>courses needed to qualify for admission</u>. TRU offers an opportunity to qualify with admission into one of the open programs, Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science. Consideration will be given to students from a variety of backgrounds with no preference given to any specific degree program or institution. As admission to UBC's program is extremely competitive, students should plan for an alternative career option.
