SAVE TIME, MONEY AND GET AHEAD

PLAR

Accelerate your program through a process called PLAR (Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition). PLAR determines whether the knowledge, skills, and abilities that mature learners have achieved outside of post-secondary can be demonstrated and assessed to gain TRU credits.

Employment, volunteering, education gained at a private institution, industry-based training, professional development, and self-study are among many possibilities that can be considered in a PLAR assessment.





Transfer credit and partnerships

If you have previous education or training you may be eligible for credit toward a TRU program. We have transfer agreements in place with many partner institutions and organizations across Canada.

These pathways allow students to take current credentials and ladder up to a TRU degree with transfer or PLAR credits.

THE PROCESS

Programs and courses

Our programs have open admissions and require you to apply online. You can enrol in most courses anywhere, at any time and study at your own pace.


